- + Identify aviation career options in flight schools, airports, and airlines
- + Build aviation vocabulary and communication confidence
- + Recognize safety, professionalism, and commitment in aviation
- + Prepare a simple next-step aviation career plan

Students learn through instructor-led lessons, career-focused discussions, aviation examples, pathway planning activities, and applied assignments.
